THE BUZZ OF WHAT'S NEW IN DOWNTOWN HATLEY.

With the closing of the Barrel Inn Bar and Restaurant in downtown Hatley in July, we were a Village with a shrinking downtown. Thanks to Tyler Kiser, a local Hatley resident along with his partner Daniel Hoehn who purchased the property and went to work on an aggressive interior remodeling plan, the Hatley Hangout opened it's doors for business in early September. Lots of improvements have taken place in the interior of the building such as a new bar, new epoxy floor, new lighting, new kitchen and bar equipment, new walk-in cooler, fresh paint, seven TV's added, new bar stools, along with new dining tables and chairs. The bathrooms are scheduled for a remodel as well. The owners advise they are not done, plans are for an outdoor remodel, outdoor seating and improving the parking lot, lot's of improvements in a short time, with more on the way. The bar and restaurant opens at 10 a.m. on Friday, Saturday and Sunday and 11 a.m. the remainder of the week. The restaurant offers daily noon lunches and evening food specials served to 9 p.m. weekdays and 10 p.m. weekends. Some of the big hits are the Friday Fish Fry and the Sunday Broasted Chicken. Hatley Area Senior Group Resume Monthly Activities

The Hatley Senior Group has resumed monthly get togethers at the Hatley Community Center activity room.

Get togethers are scheduled for October 4th, November 1st, and December 6th. Activities begin at 11 a.m. with a social hour, followed by Noon Potluck and Bingo.

NO reservations are required. Bring a dish to pass and a \$1.50 wrapped bingo prize item. Dues are \$2.00 per meeting. Blood pressure screening is available.

The monthly meetings are open to ALL seniors in the Village of Hatley and surrounding area. Please help spread the word to friends and relatives.

The Village of Hatley Water and Wastewater plant operate under permits issued by the WDNR.

The permit renews every 5 years and prior to renewal an overall audit/review is conducted by the WDNR. The review pointed out our chloride count is rising. This is common to expect due to the hard water in the Hatley area and the growth the Village of Hatley has experienced in the last 10 years. Many homes have installed water softeners that use salt. The water softeners process the water through salt and the water is recycled through the wastewater plant, salt increases chlorides.

Tips on what each household can do that has a water softener include: (1) set softener on auto cycle; (2) do not plumb softeners in floor drains; (3) have the softener checked regularly so it runs efficiently and limits the use of salt; (4) when purchasing a water softener research buying a NO salt conditioner.

VILLAGE UPDATES:

The refurbishing of the wastewater clarifier located in the wastewater treatment building was completed in early July by Process Equipment Repair Service (PERS) from West Bend, WI. Clarification is an essential step in the wastewater treatment process that operates 24/7 in the removal of floating and settleable solids prior to the release of the cleaned water into the soil. All moving parts of the system were inspected, cleaned and painted along with necessary part replacements made.

The Village of Hatley is applying to be designated as an ICE AGE TRAIL COMMUNITY. The Village Board along with members of the Ice Age Trail organization are discussing how we can help each other and the members that hike the trail. Additional information on the Ice Age Trail is available at the library or online at IceAgeTrail.org

MSA of Rhinelander, WI has been designated by WISDOT to do the engineering required for the Columbes Street Bridge Replacement in the Village of Hatley. Design work has begun on this project with construction scheduled for 2025.

FALL CLEAN-UP: FRIDAY OCT. 27

Items should be placed at your curb side by 6AM Friday, October 27.

Remember to remove doors from items such as refrigerators. Often several different trucks pick up various items, so all your items may not be picked up at the same time.

A permit must be acquired prior to starting installation of the fencing and must comply with the ordinance fencing codes.
