SNOW GUIDELINES FOR VILLAGE RESIDENTS

In order to aid the Village in the removal of snow and ice, here are some guidelines:

- Do not park your vehicle(s) on the street during a snowfall until the street has been plowed curb to curb (shoulder to shoulder) or during a snow emergency.
- Do not plow snow from your driveway across or onto the street.
- Do not place garbage/recycling containers in the street.
- Mailboxes should be checked for structural strength and correct placement. If the mailbox is damaged due to indirect contact, including the force of snow generated by snow removal, the mailbox owner assumes responsibility.
- Placing of landscaping markers in the road right-of-way prevent the plow or grader operator from properly cleaning or scraping the streets. This practice is discouraged and the Village assumes no responsibility for any damaged markers.

November 5, 2024 GENERAL ELECTION

**VILLAGE OF HATLEY RESIDENTS POLLING
LOCATION IS THE HATLEY LIBRARY/COMMUNITY
CENTER - 435 CURTIS AVENUE, HATLEY. POLLS ARE
OPEN FROM 7:00 AM TO 8:00 PM ON ELECTION DAY**

You must be at least 18 years of age, a U.S. citizen and reside in the Village of Hatley for 28 days prior. You must present a photo ID to vote.

If you are not already registered to vote, you may do so on election day. You will need to provide a photo ID and proof of residence. If your drivers license shows your Village of Hatley address, that will be your proof of residence and that is all you will need. If your drivers license does not show your Village of Hatley address, you will also need to provide proof of residence (utility bill, bank statement, residence lease, etc.)

You may also register to vote by going to myvote.wi.gov.

You may also apply to receive an absentee ballot in the mail by going to myvote.wi.gov.

If you are registered to vote, you may Absentee Vote in Person from October 22, 2024 - November 3, 2024 by contacting Joan Fraaza at 715-574-2597 and scheduling an appointment. The location is the Hatley Library/Community Center and you must provide a photo ID.

BUILDING PERMITS ARE REQUIRED FOR ANY WORK VALUED OVER \$500

Please be advised constructing fencing in your yard requires a permit. We have had some fences installed without applying for a permit. A permit must be acquired prior to starting installation of the fencing and must comply with the ordinance fencing codes.

Please contact Zoning Administrator Bill Karschney at 446-3571 for your permit or to inquire if a permit is needed for your project.
